Project Description: The Vallukad School, initiated by the Vinay Vihar Kevadi Mandal trust in 1963, is a beacon of education in the rural region of Paltana Vallukad, Gujarat. The project aims to provide holistic education, including residential facilities, to 1100 girls from local villages, spanning from 1st to 12th standard, along with a sports school and a B.A and B.Com Girls College.

The school provides residence for 1100 girls, ensuring access to education for those who cannot afford city schools.

The future holds the establishment of the Gujarat Welfare - Gyan Shakti Residential School in June 2024, aiming to accommodate 300 children in its inaugural year and expanding exponentially in subsequent years.
